Dear Jan,

Do you have any "unfinished business" from your time in The Master's Program?

You remember the core code for TMP. It's the Calling Convergence: the Vinn model that brings *God's Kingdom Purpose*, your *God-Honoring Passion* and your *God-Designed Potential* into a power linkage. At the point of convergence, you find the filter that sorts-out the opportunities that advance your Kingdom Calling.

The Enemy has attacked you as you've worked to clarify those elements; he wants to deny us the clarity that focuses our capacity on the initiatives that will matter most. One of those factors – your God-Honoring Passion – is a predictable point of conflict. Hosted at Smiling Moose Lodge – a ranch in Southwestern Montana, along the Madison River - the Tuesday-Sunday week brings 12 men together (two leads; 10 participants) to catch (and release!) massive trout... and to do a "field check" in a distraction-free setting, to strengthen the heart issues that can amplify the sound of God's voice, speaking to the soul.

Over four months this summer, scores of guys will experience the Wild Adventure (one of our ministry partners – working under our non-profit entity). We're booked to 95% of capacity for 2019... but we have a half-dozen slots open up for some lucky last-minute joiners.

I always leave better than I came, understanding more about how God made me – and how the Enemy wants to compromise me – and finding incredible value in a week with a dozen guys who get better, together, while experiencing the awesome environment of the Montana Rockies.

Some guys come, already seasoned veterans in the fly-fishing fraternity; others (*like me*) will arrive as rookies, getting the assist from the outfitters/trainers at Smiling Moose. They'll be learning - and, catching
